The meeting of the Sports Control Board was convened on 24.06.2014 under the Chairmanship of the worthy Commissioner, KVS(HQ), New Delhi.

1	Confirmation of the Minutes of the last meeting of the Sports Control Board held on 12.07.2013. The Minutes of the last meeting of KVS National Sports Control Board held on 12.07.2013 have been circulated vide letter dated 01.08.2013 to all members. Since no comments have been received, the minutes may be confirmed (see Annexure - I).	Minutes were confirmed.
2	Action Taken Report on the decision taken in the last meeting. The 44 th KVS National Sports Meet – 2013 was held in Guwahati and Delhi Region (for Girls) from 19 th to 23 rd October, 2013 and in Chennai and Chandigarh Region (for boys) 20 th to 25 th October, 2013 & 22 nd to 28 th October, 2013 respectively as per decision taken in the last meeting. Nearly 3000 Girls participated in KVS National Sports Meet-2013 at Guwahati Region while as 4300 & 1700 Boys participated at Chandigarh and Chennai Region respectively. The Inter-KV Tournaments were also held in six events as per the decision taken in the last meeting. The expenditure statement for conduct of 44 th National Sports Meet – 2013 has not been received from the host regions (excluding Chennai).	The host Regions concerned were asked to submit expenditure statements within 03 months after completion of the National Sports Meet for all events in future.
3.	Review of decision regarding Under-14 Tournaments. The decision to eliminate Under-14 age group events from 44 th KVS National Sports Meet-2014 was taken in the last meeting. The decision was taken to avoid overcrowding at the National venues especially on the basis of experience of 43 rd KVS National Sports Meet-2012 when nearly 10,000 Boys and 6,000 Girls reported at National Sports Meet at Lucknow and Mumbai respectively. However, subsequent to this decision various stake holders raised the issue and have approached KVS for inclusion of under-14 events. The Board may review and decide please.	The Board discussed the issue in detail and decided that it will not be feasible to restore U-14 age group tournaments in National Sports Meet.
4.	A detailed guidelines for conduct of 44 th KVS National Sports Meet-2013 has been issued vide letter No.F.110355/01/2013/KVS(HQ)/Sports/NSM-2013 dated 30.08.2013 (see Annexure – II). The suggestions if any for turther improvement may please be discussed in the House, so that similar guidelines can be issued for 45 th KVS National Sports Meet-2014. The dates for 45 th KVS National Sports Meet-2014 proposed by KVS, Ahmedabad Regions for Girls. The dates are from 14 th to 18 th October, 2014 and the same may be approved. However, Varanasi Region has declined and Hyderabad Region has expressed its reservation in organizing KVS National Sports Meet-2014 due to Telengana issue. Accordingly, Commissioner, KVS has decided that Delhi and Gurgaon Regions may organize 45 th National Sports Meet-2014 for boys. The Board may discuss and decide, further	Board approved and decided to issue similar guidelines for 45 th KVS National Sports Meet for 2014. However, 6 th position of 44 th KVS National Sports Meet – 2013 will be the bench mark for participation in 45 th KVS National Sports Meet-2014 for KVS tournaments at National level. The maximum number of participants in an event recommended however will remain the same as specified (fixed) earlier subject to bench mark.

Some parents and other stake holders have approached KVS for encouraging students who due their individual efforts excel in sports at National and International level. As per existing scheme students who excel at SGFI or KVS National Sports Meet are only awarded cash awards as under:-

The Board decided to honour students who participate in International events by awarding Rs.25,000/- out of NSCB on case to case basis on the recommendations of the Kendriya Vidyalaya and Regional offices concerned. The Board also decided to honour KV students who excel at National level (selected for Indian team and / or participate in National events) by awarding Rs.20,000/- cash on the case to case basis subject to specific recommendation of KV and RO concerned.

7.	KV premises/playground for use of outsider agencies (commercial use) etc.	
	Some private agencies/association have approached KVS for making use of sports infrastructure like grounds, courts etc. available for coaching purpose both KV & non KV students with a provision for charging fee for the services. From the table to above it may please be noted that only 47 proposals were found complete in all respects and approvals could be accorded after a lot of correspondence with the Regional Offices concerned. The discrepancies found in general were as under:

##

- Estimates for construction were sent without required documents as prescribed in KVS(HQ) letter No. F.110357/01/2011-KVS(HQ)/Sports/dated 06.11.2012 (See Annexure - VII).
- 2. Details of existing facilities were not provided.
- 3. Lay out plan of the Vidyalaya campus with proposed site is generally not provided by RO/KVs.
- The recommendations of RO/DC concerned were not found in most of the cases, but instead the R.Os simply forwarded the proposals.
- In a few cases a check on the kind of facility and number of such facilities already available in the Region was not made at RO level.
- In spite of returning a few proposals with above observations, the ROs kept on forwarding other
 proposals without proper scrutiny and adherence to the prescribed check list or instructions conveyed by
 KVS(HQ).

It is therefore earnestly requested that due attention may be paid at RO and KV level and check list may be followed strictly (specifically requirements as above) so that approval/sanction can be issued expeditiously. Further, Regional Offices are also requested to settle the accounts within the prescribed time limit as specified in Sanction Orders of the projects.

The instructions will be strictly adhered to so that proposals can be approved expeditiously. Due attention is to be paid by regions concerned to points listed out herein.

18. Major Sports Infrastructure Projects costing more than Rs. 1.00 Crore.

KVS (HQ) has received a number of Major Sports Infrastructure development projects costing nearly Rs.1.00 Crore and above. Keeping in view, the nature of these major projects which include facilities like Indoor Stadium Swimming Pool, Fields with Astroturf etc., the matter was discussed in in-house meeting under the Chairmanship of the Addl. Commissioner (Acad.) and Executive Engineer (Works Branch, KVS(HQ) on 20.01.2014. The In-house committee has decided that such major projects will be considered, if accompanied by the following recommendations of the Deputy Commissioner of the region:

- 1. that there is a need for such a facility in his/her region.
- 2. that there will be optimum utilization of such major sports projects.
- 3. that the maintenance of the facility will also be ensured after the commissioning of the sports infrastructure development projects.
