

**Rates of Dearness Allowance applicable with effect from
1-1-2015 to employees of Central Government and
Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their
pay in the pre-revised scale as per Fifth Central Pay
Commission**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even number, dated the 25th September, 2014 revising the rates of Dearness Allowance in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scales of pay as per Fifth Central Pay Commission.

2. The rates of Dearness Allowance admissible to the above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 212% to 223% with effect from 1-1-2015. All other conditions as laid down in the O.M. of even number, dated the 3rd October, 2008 will continue to apply.

3. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of the organizations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.

**Rounding off of a fraction of a rupee in regulation of additional
pension**

The undersigned is directed to say that vide this Department's O.M.No.38/37/08-P&PW (A), dated 1-9-2008 and O.M.No.38/37/08-P&PW (A), dated 2-9-2008. Instructions were issued for grant of additional pension/family pension @ 20% to 100% to old pensioners/family pensioners of the age of 80 years and above.

2. A question has been raised as to how the amount of additional pension is to be regulated in case the additional pension results in fraction of a rupee. The matter has been examined in consultation with Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) and it has been decided that the amount of additional pension as finally calculated may be rounded off to the next higher rupee. In cases where the pension/family pension of old pensioners has been fixed/revised without rounding off the additional pension, in those cases also, the additional pension may be rounded off to the next higher rupee hereinafter. However, no arrears for the period from 1-1-2006 on account of such rounding off would be paid in those cases.

3. This issues with the approval of Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) ID No.157/E.V/2015, dated 30-3-2015.

Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 1-1-2015

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M.No.42/10/2014-P&PW(G), dated the 29th September, 2014 on the subject-mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief(DR) payable to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 107% to 113% with effect from 1st January, 2015.

These orders apply to (i) All Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners, (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India service Pensioners, (iv) Railway Pensioners and (v) The Burma Civilian Pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan, who are Indian Nationals but receiving pension on behalf of Government of Pakistan and are in receipt of ad hoc ex gratia allowance of Rs.3500p.m. in terms of this department's O.M.No.23/1/97-P & PW(B), dated 23-2-1998 read with this Department's O.M.No.23/3/2008-P&PW(B), dated 15-9-2008.

Central Government Employees who had drawn lumpsum amount on absorption in a PSU/Autonomous body and have become eligible to restoration of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount in terms of this Department's O.M.No.4/59/97-P&PW(Dated) dated 14-7-1998 will also be entitled to the payment of DR @ 113% with effect from 1-1-2015 on full pension, i.e. the revised pension which the absorbed employee would have received on the date of restoration had he not drawn lump sum payment on absorption and Dearness Pension subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down in Para.5 of the O.M., dated 14-7-1998. In this connection instructions contained in this Department's O.M.No.4/29/99-P&PW (Dated), dated 12-7-2000 refer.

4. Payment of DR involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's O.M.No.45/73/97-P&PW(G), dated 2-7-1999 as amended vide this Department's O.M.No.F.No.38/88/2008-P&PW(G), dated the 9th July, 2009. The Provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc., to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

8. The offices of Accountant General and Authorized Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners, etc., on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of Letter No. 528-TA, II/34-80-II, dated 23-4-1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64/CGL/81, dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its branches and all Nationalized Banks.

9. In their application to the pensioners / family pensioners belonging to the Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.

10. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure conveyed vide their ID No. 1 (4)/E.V/2004, dated 24th April, 2015.

**Leave Travel Concession (LTC) entitlements of unmarried
Government servants-Conversion of Home Town LTC facility into
travel to different parts of the country permissible under the special
dispensation scheme – Clarification.**

In relaxation to the Central Civil Services (Leave Travel Concession) rules, 1988, special dispensation is allowed to the Government servants from time to time. Presently, one such dispensation in operation is the relaxation to the Government servants to travel by air to visit North-East Region or to Jammu and Kashmir or to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands by converting one block of Home Town LTC available to them.

2. Vide this Department's Office Memorandum No.31011/17/85-Estt.(A), dated 3-4-1986, unmarried Central Government employees, who have left their wholly dependent parents/sisters/minor brothers at their home town are allowed the benefit of LTC to visit their home town every year. This concession is in lieu of all other LTC facilities admissible to the Government servant himself and to his/her parents/sisters/minor brothers.

The Department is in receipt of references seeking clarification on the possibility of conversion of Home Town LTC facility into travel to different parts of the country, which is permissible under special dispensation, to such unmarried Government servants.

The matter has been examined in consultation with Ministry of Home Affairs. It has been decided that the facility of conversion of Home Town LTC into travel to different parts of the country, under the special dispensation scheme, will also apply to an unmarried Central Government servant who is eligible to avail the benefit of LTC to visit Home Town. This facility may be availed by converting one occasion of Home Town LTC out of the four Home Town LTC occasions available in a year.

**Travel by Premium Trains on Official Duty / Tour / Training /
Transfer, etc. — Clarification**

References have been received in this Department seeking clarification regarding entitlement of Central Government servants to travel by "Premium Trains", being run by the Indian Railways, while on Official Duty / Tour / Training / Transfer, etc.

2. It is clarified that travel by Premium Trains by Central Government servants on Official Duty / Tour / Training / Transfer, etc. is not allowed and therefore, the fare charged for Premium Trains by the Indian Railways for the journey performed by Premium Trains shall not be reimbursable. In cases where journey on Official Duty / Tour / Training / Transfer, etc., has already been performed by Premium Trains, the amount reimbursed shall be restricted to the admissible normal fare for the entitled class of train travel or the actual fare paid, whichever is less.

**Central Civil Services (Leave Travel Concession) Rules, 1988 —
Clarification regarding eligibility of Home Town Concession —
Frequently Asked Questions**

The undersigned is directed to say that this Department receives number of references from Government servants / various Ministries Departments seeking clarifications regarding the eligibility of Government employees in respect of Home Town LTC. The point of doubts raised and their clarifications are as under:—

1.	Whether the Government employees whose Headquarters / Place of posting and Home Town are same, are eligible for Home Town LTC?	No. Government employees whose headquarters / place of posting and Home Town are one and the same are not eligible for Home Town LTC.

Whether the Government employees who are not eligible for Home Town LTC may avail the Special Concession scheme of conversion of Home Town LTC to travel to North-East Region, Jammu and Kashmir and Andaman and Nicobar Islands as allowed by DoP&T's O.M. No. 31011/3/2014-Estt. A-IV, dated 12-9-2014?	No. Employees whose Home Town and Headquarters are same are not eligible for Home Town LTC and hence, the question of conversion of Home Town LTC to travel to these places under special concession scheme does not arise.
	Whether the Government employees residing in cities / towns outside Delhi which fall under other states of National Capital Region (NCR) are eligible for Home Town Concession?	Yes. Cities / towns which are outside Delhi and fall in other states of NCR are not to be treated as Delhi Headquarters. Hence, the Government employees whose headquarters are Delhi and reside in cities / towns outside Delhi falling in other states of NCR, are eligible for Home Town Concession.
