Madam/Sir,

Enclosed please find herewith Guidelines for conduct of 44th KVS National Sports Meet, 2013 alongwith Annexures, as approved by Competent Authority. It is pertinent to mention that prior to National Sports Meet 2013, Zonal Sports Meets at 05 different venues will be organized as per these guidelines.

There will essentially be no change in organization of Sports Meet at Regional Level and same is to be completed before August, 2013. However, the winner KV teams at Regional level in different games will also be sponsored by Regions for the Zonal sports meet as a part of Regional contingent.

For details please see the Guidelines carefully. The Guidelines for conduct of KVS Sports Meet, 2013 are also available on KVS website www.kvsangathan.nic.in/Academic/Circulars. Please note that exact dates, venues and other finer details of Zonal/National Meet will be decided during the Annual meeting of NSCB.

This may be circulated amongst the Kendriya Vidyalayas of your Region for information and necessary action.

Background:

The 50th year of KVS, with its inception in the year 1963, is an important milestone in its long journey. Beginning with 20 regimental schools and its growth to more than one thousand (1090) Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) at present is a remarkable achievement. KVS has always given importance to extra-curricular activities *including sports*, besides academics, which has added to the overall development of its students and the same has been widely acknowledged by the society.

The successful organization of 43 KVS Annual Sports Meets till 2012 and participation of thousands of the budding sports persons available in Kendriya Vidyalayas every year in these events including SGFI games is a significant achievement. Further, the Inter-KV tournaments at KVS National level have also been organized in different team games successfully from last two years. The overall growth of the organization and addition of seven more KVS Regions in the recent past, especially the conduct of 43rd KVS National sports at Lucknow and Mumbai, has thrown up a few challenges in front of various stake holders of KVS.

After the participation of a record number nearly 10000 boys and 6000 girls from 25 KVS Regions in the 43rd KVS National Sports Meet 2012, an urgent need was felt to streamline the organization of the KVS National Sports Meet. To encourage mass participation without compromising quality and to restrict over-crowding during the KVS National Sports meet, a committee was set up at KVS HQ to suggest possible measures in this regard. The Committee after deliberating on the issue submitted its recommendations and accordingly it has been decided to introduce the system of KVS Zonal Sports Meet before KVS National sports Meet and blend the Inter KV tournaments into the system.

To ensure quality participation and reduce the crowd, the Games and Sports will henceforth, be organized in three tier system viz. Regional, Zonal and National. One Regional winner team (KV Team) and one mixed Regional team of the talented players of the Region will now be allowed to participate in Zonal Tournaments. In other words 10 teams (2X5 Regions) in each Game will participate in Zonal Sports Meet besides other games/individual events. Thereafter, one Zonal team (mixed from Regional teams) and one KV winner team at Zonal level will be allowed to participate in National Meet. However, in case of individual events only winners will be allowed to participate in Zonal and Nationals. Since Zonal winner teams will consist of mixed Regional teams, the Regional identity will be lost after Zonal Meet. To address this issue all selected players in viz. individual events, KV teams, selected players of the Regions in Zonal team will comprise the Regional contingents, for March Past & other such purposes.

This mechanism will reduce the number of teams /participants (individuals) considerably at one venue (Zonal/National) and yet at the same time Zonal tournaments will open up more opportunities to participants to compete and excel (improve quality) as compared to the rush at National level. The Zonal level will reduce the travel time (movement of a large number of students) as well as the duration of sports meet can be reduced to 03 days because of less number of teams (05 sets of teams in each Game/Event) will be participating both at Zonal and National levels. This mechanism has also the advantage of giving an opportunity to strengthening Inter-KV system as well as identifying sports talent for the National and SGFI in more focused manner. The Regional selections will now be followed by Zonal selections and then finally National level selection for SGFI. (Details are given in the following heads.)

- I. The KVS National Sports Meet will be organised in the following games/events and selected/identified talented players in these games/events will be sponsored for SGFI :-

1. KVS Zonal Sports meet will be organised prior to 44th KVS National Sports Meet in 2013.
2. Five Regions in each Zone will participate in KVS Zonal Sports Meet.

3. Identification of best sports talent and encouraging Inter-KV competition has been essentially blended in the scheme without any major deviation from existing practice.
4. Mixed KV (Regional) teams and Mixed Regional (Zonal) teams will give opportunity to talented players to compete for KVS National (SGFI) team. This will further make selection process more focussed by reducing the number of contestants at each level i.e. Zonal and National.
5. Regional teams will essentially lose their identity beyond Zonal level; however, winner KV teams (see 7 below) will maintain their identity till National Level.
6. Only **(1) Winners in Individual events/semi team games (See Annexure III), (2) Zonal (mixed-Region) teams and (3) Winner KV teams (see 7 below) at Zonal (from Five Zones) level will be eligible to participate in KVS National Sports Meet.**
7. In Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket (Nine team games; Boys-Girls as applicable) KVS National winners and Runners-Up 'KV-team' will be declared instead of Regional or Zonal teams.
8. **The KVS teams of talented players for SGFI in each game/event will be selected during the KVS National sports meet out of talented players identified at Zonal Level. In other words the regional selections will now be followed by Zonal selections and then finally National level selection for SGFI as per practice.**

iii. Regional Sports Meet

1. There will be essentially no change in organising Sports Meet at Regional Level.
2. The modalities for conduct of Regional Sports meet including travel/escorting duties up to Zonal/National level will be decided at Regional level by the Deputy Commissioner of the Region. A Committee may be appointed with DC concerned as the Chairman in this regard for maintaining transparency and to avoid grievances/complaints at a later stage.
3. **The Regions will select and sponsor Regional Teams (mixed KV/talented players) and Best Players/Winners in individual/semi-team events in all Games and sports, as per existing practice, for KVS Zonal Sports Meet.**
4. **The Regions will also Sponsor the 'Winner-KV-team' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket (Nine team games; Boys-Girls as applicable) as a part of Regional contingent for Zonal Sports Meet.** In other words each Region will sponsor one Regional (mixed-KV-team) team and one Regional 'Winner-KV-team' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket.
5. **The best/Talented players in the 'Winner-KV-teams' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket may also belong to Regional (mixed-KV) teams which imply that winner KV-team's (talented) players can/may play for the Region also.**

6. The Regions should be careful while identifying (selecting) 'Talented Players' for Regional Team because only these players playing for the Region will be considered for Zonal and other Higher levels. In other words beyond Regional selection the Inter KV tournaments will not be used as a platform for selecting 'Talented Players' Zonal/National/SGFI.
7. *Other than* Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket KV teams, selections will be made as per usual practice.
8. The Coaching camps may be organised at Regional level, however, the coaching in respect of KV teams will be the responsibility of the Vidyalaya/Principal concerned.

IV. Zonal Sports Meet

1. KVS Zonal Sports Meet, with five regions in each Zone, will be organised in all games and sports events alongside with Inter-KV Tournament in above stated Games viz. Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket.
2. All Regional contingents/teams will bring at least 10 flags of their region with them. The flags will be of the size of 4ft. x 3ft. The colour of the flags will be the same as has been allotted for the playing kit of the players of that region. The colours allotted to the Regions can be seen at (Annexure- I)
3. All the Regions should ensure that required number of escorts is sent with the teams. The safety and security consideration should not be compromised in any case.
4. Eligibility Certificates: All participating students from all Regions will bring eligibility certificates in quadruplicate with them and submit to the venue Principal. Without the eligibility certificate, no student will be allowed to participate. Eligibility Certificates (in quadruplicate) in respect of all the students selected for the SGFI Meet should be sent to the Deputy/Assistant Commissioner (Sports) of Host region immediately for countersignatures, after the conclusion of the KVS National Meet. (Eligibility Certificate and On-line Official Entry Form is enclosed Annexure-II)
5. All matches of the inter-KV/Region tournaments will be played on league basis.
6. The Zones will select and sponsor Zonal Teams (mixed Regions/best players out of Regional Teams) and Best Players/Winners in individual/semi-team events in all Games and sports, for KVS National Sports Meet.
7. The Zones will also Sponsor the 'Winner-KV-team' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket (Nine team games; Boys-Girls as applicable) as a part of Zonal contingent for KVS National Sports Meet. In other words each Zone will sponsor one Zonal (mixed-Regions-team) team and one Zonal 'Winner-KV-team' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket (Boys-Girls as applicable).
8. The Talented/best players (provided such a selection was made at Regional Level) in the 'Winner-KV-teams' in Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey,

Football, Throw Ball and Cricket may also belong to Zonal (mixed-Region) teams which imply that Winner KV-teams' talented players can/may also play for the Zonal team also.

9. **Beyond Regional selection the inter-KV tournaments will not be used as a platform for selecting 'Talented Players' for Zonal/National/SGFI. The Regions should therefore, be careful while identifying (selecting) 'Talented Players' for Regional Team because only these players playing for the Region will be considered for Zonal and other Higher levels.**
10. The talented Players playing for a Region (Mixed team) will only be considered for a Zonal (Mixed Region) team of talented players.
11. After Zonal Sports Meet the Regional contingents will move back to their parent KVs. **Coaching Camps will not be arranged by Zonal Hosts for players/teams selected for Nationals.**
12. **The travel and escorting arrangements up to National Venue of the players/teams selected at Zonal Level for KVS Nationals will be made by the parent Region and not by Zonal Host.**

V. **Sports and Games Meet- General Guidelines**

1. The details of age-groups and the class up to which the students are eligible to participate in these games are:-
 - a) Under-11 years as on 31.12.2013 and up to class V and born on or after 01.01.2003
 - b) Under-14 years as on 31.12.2013 and up to Class VIII and born on or after 01.01.2000
 - c) Under-16 years as on 31.12.2013 and up to Class X and born on or after 01.01.1998
 - d) Under-17 years as on 31.12.2013 and up to Class X and born on or after 01.01.1997
 - e) Under-19 years as on 31.12.2013 and up to Class XII and born on or after 01.01.1995
2. **Proper Sports Infrastructure**, as far as Courts/Grounds/Halls etc. is concerned, for the sports meet at all levels Regional, Zonal, and National should be ensured by the Host KV/Regional Office concerned. At least two Grounds should be made available to run inter-KV and Inter-Regional/Zonal tournaments concurrently in team games viz. Handball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Hockey, Football, Throw Ball and Cricket.
3. All matches of the inter-KV/Region tournaments will be played on league basis. However, for Regional Sports meet the Deputy Commissioner of the region concerned will be competent to decide modalities for Regional tournaments as per feasibility.
4. **Beyond Regional selection, the inter-KV tournaments will not be used as a platform for selecting 'Talented Players' for Zonal/National/SGFI. The Regions should therefore, be careful while identifying (selecting) 'Talented Players' for Regional Team because only these players playing for the Region will be considered for Zonal and other Higher levels.**

5. The competitions in the Team games of Table-Tennis, Badminton and Tennis will be held as "1st Singles, Doubles and 2nd Singles. For Individual events of Badminton, Table Tennis, and Tennis, top five seeds" can play for Individual singles and top five winning students of individual Singles can be selected for the next higher level. The regions will invite entries from individual players for Regional level singles tournaments and conduct the Regional level competitions. In the KVS National Sports Meet, the best five singles players may be deputed for SGFI Meet. Total no. of players for the event will not exceed five in each age group.
6. In Athletics and Swimming first position and second position holder can be selected for next higher level. Participants will be permitted to participate in maximum three events, excluding relays. This will further be subject to the condition that performance is above the 6th place of KVS record in the last year.
7. In individual events players will not be selected without contesting three fights/matches. In case such scope of fight/matches does not exist in an event the participant cannot be declared as a winner.

There has to be three rounds in each match. In each round maximum number of points will be nine. Any player who wins maximum number of points in all the three rounds in each weight and age category will be declared winner. There is no restriction on number of players in weight / age category of all individual events. If the number of participants is less than three, a participation certificate may be awarded to individual concerned and he/she may be selected for next higher level (no medal and cash prize will be given in such a case).

If a single contestant reports in an event like judo, taekwondo, boxing of a particular age/weight category, he may be permitted to proceed to next level but should not be declared as winner, however certificate of participation may be issued.

8. Competitions will be organized for the events as prescribed within the KVS guidelines. Players should not be sponsored for events which are not conducted in KVS (see para I).
9. Selection of Kabaddi team will be done on the basis of weight category as per SGFI Norms (see Annexure III).
10. Tug of War may be played up to the school level. Matches can be organized at inter school level. Individual KV can participate in the tournaments organized by regional centers/Tug of War Federation of India.
11. A skater can opt for two races out of three races in quad event and three races out of four races in in-line event for inter school competition. A player can take part only in quad or in-line event. No player can take part in both the events quad and in-line. Only three participants can take part in KVS Zonal/National Sports Meet/SGFI in one age group in the event of quad and also three participants can take part in KVS Zonal/National/SGFI in the event of in-line. While selecting the team of three participants quad/in-line preference will be given to 1st place holder/gold medallist. If the team is not complete with three players who are gold medallists then silver/bronze

medallist may be selected for higher level. If the Gold medallists are more than three, then marks will be calculated as maximum points.

12. The Deputy Commissioner of the Host Region should constitute a committee to ensure minimum standard in each game/event and depute only those individual players/teams for Zonal/National level tournament which perform up to a certain standard (at least not below the 6th Position in the Previous KVS National Sports Meet). Teams should not be deputed just for the sake of participation.
13. Eligibility Certificates:-All participating students from all Regions will bring eligibility certificates in quadruplicate with them for submission at the venue (Zonal/ National as applicable). Without the eligibility certificate, no student will be allowed to participate. Eligibility Certificates (in quadruplicate) in respect of all the students selected for the SGFI Meet should be sent to the Deputy Commissioner (Sports) of Host region immediately for countersignatures, after the conclusion of the KVS National Meet. (Eligibility Certificate and On-line Official Entry Form is enclosed Annexure-II)

Note:

It should be ensured by the Regions concerned that their players participate in all the Sports Meets at all levels with proper Sports Kit and shoes. Non-compliance will be viewed seriously. The playing Kits for the players and PET'S deputed as coach should be as per Annexure –IV.

VI. Menu/Food chart for the players should be as per SGFI Norms.

1. Breakfast : 200 ml Milk, 04 pcs Bread with butter and 04 pcs Bread with jam or 06 to 08 pcs of Idli, Sambhar, Chatni or 04 pcs. Aaloo parantha. 02 pcs of banana or 01 pcs of apple and 02 eggs.
2. Lunch : Chapati, Rice, Sweet, any Dal or Rajama or Chana, Seasonal mixed vegetable, paneer for vegetarians, salad papad, pickles and chicken/fish for non-vegetarians.
3. Evening Snacks: Juice-200 ml with snacks (i.e. Sandwich/samosa/bread pakora/paneer pakora etc.)
4. Dinner: Chapati, Rice, Sweet, any Dal or Rajama or Chana, Seasonal mixed vegetable, Paneer for vegetarians, salad papad, pickles and chicken/fish for non-vegetarians.
5. Night (Bed-time): Milk – 200 ml

Note: - (1) The same scale/standard of food will be provided to the participants and escorting teachers/PETs/Coaches/Officials as mentioned above. No DA will be charged from Players/Participants/Escorting Teachers/ PETs/Coaches/Officials during stay period of the meet. (2) Mosquito repellents may also be provided for use during night.

VII. (A).Expenditure by KV :-The Vidyalayas will make the following expenditure on their teams out of the Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi/School Fund as applicable:-

- I. Expenditure on playing kit and playing equipment for participating students will be met out of the VVN of KV concerned for participating in Regional Level Meet.
- II. Expenditure on TA/DA for participating students during the journey period from their respective KV to the Venue of the Regional Level Meet and back will be met out of the VVN of KV concerned.
- III. Expenditure on TA/DA of escorting teacher/PET will be met out of the School Fund of the concerned KV at all levels. The DA however may be restricted as per rules for the periods spent at a venue where Boarding-Lodging including food has been provided by the organizers without any payment by the individuals thereto.

(B). Expenditure by the Region :

The expenditure on (i) Conduct of the Regional level tournaments in all games (ii) Playing equipment (iii) Playing kit for participating students and PET deputed as Coach (iv) Preparing play-fields (v) Honorarium to officials for the matches (vi) Boarding and lodging arrangements of every team in the regional meet (vii) Journey expenditure on TA/DA of participating students/players from their respective KV/region to the Venue of the KVS Zonal/National Sports Meet (viii) Expenditure on First-aid/medical facilities etc. will be incurred by the Regional Office out of the funds of the Regional Sports Control Board.

(C). Expenditure by KVS (HQ) :

Expenditure on conducting the KVS Zonal and National Sports Meet will be incurred by the KVS (HQ). Expenditure on playing equipment, playing kit(for SGFI players & PET deputed as coach), medical-aid, transportation, honorarium to officials for conduct of matches, purchase of medals, trophies, shields, printing of certificates and all arrangements regarding organizing of KVS Zonal and National Sports Meet in each game will also be met by the KVS(HQ).

An amount of Rs.300/- is fixed as boarding and lodging arrangement including contingent charges for participating students. For journey period more than 08 hours, the rate will be Rs.300/-. If journey period is less than 08 hours, the rate will Rs.175/-. For those students who are not staying overnight and not availing lodging facilities will be paid Rs.175/- per head per day.

VIII. CASH AWARDS

The KVS has instituted the following cash awards for the KVS National level Meet. The expenditure is to be incurred by Host Region on the Spot and later on sent to KVS (Hq) for reimbursement along with full particulars. The expenditure on cash awards will be a separate head isolated from the expenditure incurred on KVS National Meet.

- a) For individual games, cash awards of Rs.2500/-, Rs.2000/- and Rs.1500/- for winners of first three places will be given at Zonal and National level.
- b) For team games, each member of the teams will be awarded cash prize of Rs.500/-, Rs.300/- and Rs.200/- for winning the first three places, respectively, in the KVS Zonal and National Meet.
- c) All those students who win **Gold, Silver and Bronze medals** in the **SGFI** in all individual games will be awarded one-time cash scholarship of Rs.6,000/-, Rs.4,000/- and Rs.2,000/- respectively.
- d) For team games, each member of the KVS teams which win **Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals** in **SGFI** meets will be awarded cash prize of Rs.1000/-, Rs.750/- and Rs.500/- respectively.

Note: *It should be ensured that all Cash Prize will be distributed to the winners in KVS National Sports Meet & SGFI Meet by the host Regions on the Spot positively, so that unnecessary correspondence & complaints can be avoided.*
