Sub: Celebration of Sanskrit Week from 7th to 13th August 2014.

Madam/Sir,

The Government of India had declared Shravan Purnima as Sanskrit Day in 1969 and in the year 2001 it was decided to celebrate Sanskrit Week every year. The Sanskrit Week comprises 3 days before and 3 days after Shravana Poornima. This year, the Shravana Poornima will fall on 10.08.2014 and, therefore, the Sanskrit Week will be celebrated from August 7-13, 2014.

The Ministry of HRD has decided to celebrate Sanskrit Week in all Schools. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan will celebrate Sanskrit Week at three levels viz. Vidyalaya level, Regional level and National level.

At Vidyalaya level:

- 1. All Vidyalayas should conduct the morning assembly in Sanskrit on all days of the week during the Sanskrit week with a banner in the background. All the daily prayer items viz. Pledge, Thought for the Day, News, Special item, Community Song etc. should be in Sanskrit.
- 2. House level competitions should be arranged through out the week for the students of Classes VI to X in two groups by choosing from the following:
 - -Sanskrit Shloka recitation from 'Geeta Govindam'
 - Geeta Chanting competition
 - -Natya Manchan/Skit
 - -Story telling competition from Upanishads or Panchtantra in Hindi
 - -Role play/Fancy dress competitions depicting famous Sanskrit Scholars and contributors
 - -Group Song competition in Sanskrit songs
 - -Essay writing competition in Hindi about Great Sanskrit Scholars, their lives and works
 - Quiz competition on Sanskrit Literature & Language

Efforts should be made to create appreciation for the Sanskrit Language amongst students; hence Certificates and Prizes should be awarded to the students. The details of the celebration held in the Vidyalayas should be uploaded on the Vidyalaya Website immediately.

At Regional Level:

A Regional level function has to be organised under the guidance of the KVS Regional Office. The nearby Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV) in the Region should also be invited to participate with a few students & teachers in the function. The function should comprise of the following:

- Recitation of Shlokas from 'Geeta Govindam'
- Sanskrit group song/Skit
- Lectures by eminent Sanskrit Scholars.

The above items would be a part of celebration and not of a competitive nature. Hence, good selected items from a few Schools may be presented during the Regional level celebrations.

The details of the Regional level celebration of Sanskrit Week should be uploaded on the Regional Office Website immediately.

At National level:

- 1. A National level function will be organised by KVS, NVS and CBSE jointly at Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Auditorium in KV NO.2, Delhi Cantt., during the Sanskrit Week
- CBSE will conduct National level competition for all its affiliated schools including KVs in the 2. month of July. All Principals under your jurisdiction should be directed to download details of the Competitions from the CBSE Websiteand ensure active participation of the students.

It is hoped that all efforts would be made to ensure active participation of students from all KVs to make the Sanskrit Week celebration a grand success.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation of earlier letter from this office dated 4th July, 2014, please note the following changes on the subject cited above, in the light of the directions of MHRD for the celebration of Sanskrit week.

1. Vidyalaya level. (to be celebrated during 7-13 August, 2014)

As directed earlier.

2.At Regional level. (To culminate by 13 August, 2014.)

The following competitions should be conducted at Regional level.

- Shloka Recitation
- Seminar with Sanskrit teachers of the Region on the importance of Sanskrit and scriptures in contemporary world.
- Lectures by eminent Sanskrit Scholars and their interaction with students.
- One best essay from each school of the region should be sent to the Regional office and from among these, three best essays should be adjudged.
- Elocution/Story telling competitions also should be organized at Regional level, by inviting one best entry from each school of the Region.
- Geeta Chanting competition should be organized at Regional level by inviting the first prize winner from each school.

It is suggested that in addition to Geeta, texts from other classical Sanskrit literature such as Bhajgovindam, Geet Govinda etc could be taken up for chanting competition.

The nearby JNVs in the region should be invited to participate in the Regional level programmes such as Seminars, lectures, and student activities. (Please refer to letter No. F.11029/16/2014/KVS(HQ)/Sanskrit Week dt. 10.7.14 by Addl. Commissioner (Acad.) to the Commissioner NVS.)

3.At National level

- A National level function will be organized by KVS, NVS and CBSE jointly at Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Auditorium in KV No.2, Delhi Cantt during the Sanskrit Week.

It is hoped that all efforts would be made to ensure active participation of students from all KVs to make Sanskrit week celebration a the grand success.
